Mission Statement:

The Quarry Golf Club is dedicated to consistently delivering superior golf, dining, social experiences and personalized service in a warm atmosphere of camaraderie for its Members, their families, and guests.

Vision Statement:

Guiding Principles:

Providing an environment where our Members and their guests can experience the amenities and services The Quarry offers free of inappropriate behavior and appearance distractions is a critical component of our Vision.

Members and their guests are expected to conduct and present themselves courteously and thoughtfully and properly respect Club facilities, themselves, fellow members, guests, and The Quarry Staff.

Enforcement:

Members are expected to be aware of and adhere to Club policies and ensure their guests do as well. Members of the Staff will identify exceptions and report them to Management, who will discretely call them to the Member's attention either in person, if appropriate, or via email notification.

Violation of any Club rules or conduct in a manner prejudicial to the Club's best interests will subject the person in violation to disciplinary action in accordance with Club Bylaws.

Deportment Guidelines

- **Smart Devices:** Except in an emergency, the audible use of cell phones, electronic games, music devices or other personal devices is prohibited in all indoor club facilities. Discreet use of electronic devices is permitted outdoors.
 - If you are sitting at a table or lounge and receive a call on your cell phone or mobile device, kindly
 excuse yourself and proceed to the outdoor Terrace, Patio, or an area outside the clubhouse that will
 not disturb others.
 - If you are talking to the person on a cell phone or mobile device as you move to the appropriate area, please use your indoor voice. Electronic devices should not distract members and guests from enjoying the Club.
- Smoking and Chewing Tobacco: Smoking and Chewing Tobacco are prohibited in all Clubhouse Facilities.
- Pets: Pets are not allowed inside any Club facility, on the outdoor Terrace or Patio, on the golf course, or on the practice facilities. Pets are not allowed on Club property.
- **Golf Course:** The **Golf Course** is intended for those who are playing the game of golf. Walking the course, including bikes, skateboards, scooters, etc., is not permitted.
- Parking Lot: The Parking Lot is intended for motor vehicles and golf carts only. Bicycles should be parked in the designated areas with bicycle racks only. Skateboards and scooters are not permitted in the Parking Lot.
- Interaction with Staff and with One Another: Members and their guests are expected to treat each other and staff courteously. Depending upon the severity, discourteous behavior may be considered egregious and will be sent to the Board of Directors immediately for review and any necessary corrective action.
- **Club Communications and Member Directory** are for personal use only and may not be used for solicitation or distribution of any kind.

Ladies may wear hats/caps inside the clubhouse facilities after golf events. Ladies may not wear hats/caps inside the clubhouse facilities for non-golf related dining and social events.

Men may not wear hats/caps inside the clubhouse facilities at any time. Men may wear hats/caps after golf on the Terrace and East Patio.
